



## AAU COLORADO OPEN JUMP ROPE QUALIFYING TOURNAMENT

- Where:** Chatfield Senior High School

- When:** Saturday, April 29, 2017 from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
- Hosted by:** Claim Jumpers
- Who Should Come?** Anyone interested in competition Jump Rope for fun. The top 10 participants in each age-group and event, and the top 3 Group Routines teams in each age division, qualify to compete at the 2016 AAU Junior Olympic Games in Detroit, MI.
- Events:** Singles – A Triple Crown event consisting of Speed (1min.), Power (1 min.) and a Freestyle routine to music (60-75 sec.)  
Pairs – A Triple Crown event consisting of Pairs Speed (2x30 sec.), Pairs Power (2x30 sec.) and Pairs Freestyle routine to music (60-75 sec.)  
Double Dutch – A Pentathlon event with group composed of 4 people consisting of DD Single Speed (60 sec.), DD Single Power (60 sec.), DD Single Freestyle (60-75 sec.), DD Pairs Speed (4x30 sec.) and DD Pairs Freestyle (60-75 sec.)  
Group Routine with music (2 to 4 minutes); Junior and Senior; 6 – 24 person event.
- Age-groups:** Individual Females: 8 and under, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15-17, 18-22.  
Individual Males: 8 and under, 9-10, 11-12, 13-14, 15-17, 18-22.  
Mixed or same gender in all other events:  
Pairs: 8 and under, 9-10, 11-12, 13-14, 15-17, 18-22.  
Double Dutch: 10 and under, 11-12, 13-14, 15-17, 18-22.  
Group Routines: Junior is 13 and under and Senior is 14-22  
Age is determined by the competitor's age on June 15, 2016.
- In multi-person events, age is determined by the age of the oldest competitor in the event.
- Awards:** Gold, Silver and Bronze for All Around winners in each event and age-group.  
1<sup>st</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> place ribbons for component events.
- Cost:** \$40 registration fee
- Rules:** 2017 AAU competition rules will apply. A copy of the 2017 AAU Jump Rope Rulebook (Handbook) can be downloaded at [www.aajumprope.org](http://www.aajumprope.org).
- Officials:** Please note that for AAU Jump Rope Competition, one official must be provided for every 4 athletes competing from a team.
