DIVISIONS

Athletes may qualify for the National Championships in the following divisions by attending the Inland Empire AAU Regional's: Kata, Kobudo or Kumite

WBC reserves the right to move competitors in divisions as needed due to qualified registrations. All fees are non-refundable.

RULES

Please keep in mind, if you plan to participate in the Regional and National karate competitions you must wear the AAU patch and be an AAU member.

MANDATORY EQUIPMENT

Headgear, chest protectors, mouth guards and athletic protectors for male athletes are required for all junior athletes in kumite competition. Chest protectors are required for female competitors. Certified prescription glasses with strap.
